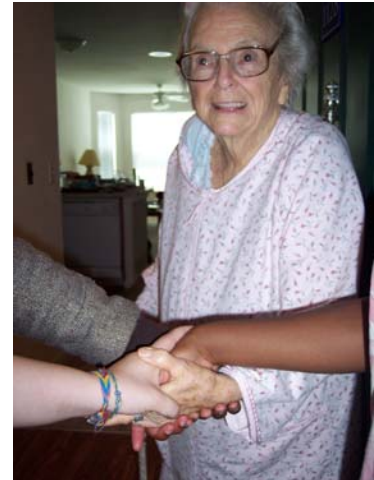

Fast Facts about Senior Hunger:

- ◆ Over 30,000 residents of Johnson and Ellis Counties are over the age of 60.
- ◆ Of that number, 25% live alone.
- ◆ At least 9,800 are considered to be moderately to severely impaired.
- ◆ The fastest growing age group in the U.S. is persons 85 and older.
- ◆ Over 30% of seniors live at or below the poverty level.

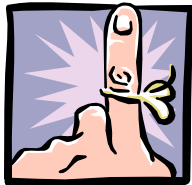


Meals on Wheels of Johnson and Ellis Counties is currently serving:

- ◆ An average of 700 hot meals a day, with 81 meal delivery routes each day
- ◆ 95% of these meals are delivered by volunteers
- ◆ An area of over 1,700 square miles

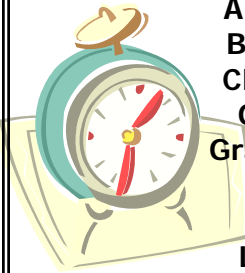

Route Pickup Times

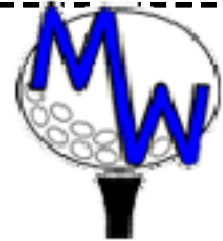
